

SQUASHMATRIX AND YOUR PRIVACY RIGHTS

At SquashMatrix, we take your privacy rights seriously, and will take all reasonable steps to ensure that our legal and moral obligations to you are met.

Due to the nature of the service, we may hold a variety of personal information about you, which may include your name, date of birth, current address, work, home and mobile telephone numbers, e-mail address, squash club membership, competition participation details, and a photograph.

We collect this information about you principally from you – from the form that you complete to register for a competition run or sponsored by us, or when you advise us that your details need to be updated. If you choose not to provide some of this information, it may affect our ability (as well as others) to contact you and to provide you with the level of service that we would like to offer.

Any of the personal information held by us will be used principally for the following reasons:

- (a) To circulate messages and news to you to keep you informed of events relating to squash in your state or territory;
- (b) To manage the game of squash in your state or territory;
- (c) To give you access and to inform you of changes to the websites and other content, products and services available from these websites;
- (d) To administer and manage the websites;
- (e) To provide data in aggregated form to Government agencies and departments for the purposes of seeking financial grants and statistical analysis.

SquashMatrix also use 'cookies' on our website. We use cookies to remember your settings (such as your favorite page) and to automatically log you on if you choose to do so, and as such, is designed to improve your experience of the SquashMatrix web-site. Cookies are an industry standard and most major web sites use them. In some cases, cookies may collect and store personal information about you. You can adjust your Internet browser to disable cookies or to warn you when cookies are being used. However, if you disable cookies, you may not be able to take advantage of the improved web site experience that cookies offer.

At all times you have the ability to check the data that we hold on you and for you to update or correct any errors. You can do this on-line or you can e-mail the SquashMatrix office and inform us.

You can also hide your personal details from view, and only make them available to other registered squash players. We have done this to remove the capacity of spammers and others to use your contact details for nuisance purposes. You can also choose to make your contact details 'hidden' from public view.

We welcome feedback on our privacy policy, and would encourage you to provide any comments to the SquashMatrix administrators.
